Go to roundabout, follow the signs for Town Centre, through traffic lights to the mini roundabout, take left fork, pass the golf course on your left, through traffic lights, Millwood House is on the corner at the second turning on the right.

From the West A82.

Continue into town centre over river, straight ahead at traffic lights, past Town House on right, continue up Castle Street, first left up Old Edinburgh Rd, through traffic lights, turn first right continuing down Old Edinburgh Rd., first left, Millwood House is the second house on the left

Exploring in the Highlands

Inverness the capital of the Highlands is steeped in history and legend, it is the perfect location for a touring holiday. Surrounded by dramatic and inspiring countryside whatever the time of year you visit there are peaceful places to be found in this area of unsurpassed splendid beauty. A lovely day out can be spent on the rugged west coast, sail over the sea to Skye, visiting Dunvegan Castle or a boat trip to see the seals lazing on the rocks. Shin Falls in Sutherland where you can watch the rare sight of Atlantic salmon leaping up the magnificent waterfall. The National Trust gardens at Inverewe - a sub-tropical wonderland of flowers and trees. Ullapool, just nestling at the end of Loch Broom with the Summer Isles just beyond. Balmoral, Royal Dee-side, the Spey Valley, all these places can be visited for the day. Take the Whisky Trail as there are many distilleries in the area. Numerous archaeological sites of great interest and many forest trails. For the sportsman there is golf, skiing, fishing, clay pigeon shooting, pony trekking, mountain biking, sailing and water sports. These are just some of the many things for you to discover in the beautiful Highlands of Scotland. You are sure to take home so many special memories that will last a lifetime.

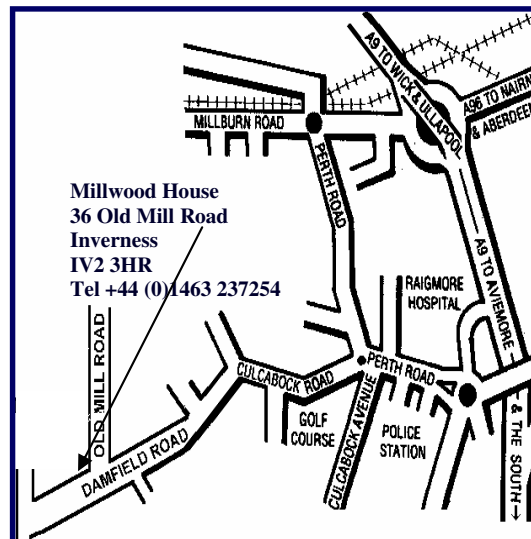
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
